Best Fruit Varieties for Backyard Growing

Avocado - Naturally dwarf types include 'Rincon' (A), 'Pinkerton' (A), 'Wurtz' (A), 'Hazzard' (A). Other options both with good self pollination = 'Lamb Hass' (A) and 'Fuerte' (B)

Banana - Saba, Pisang Ceylon, Blue Java, Terema, Senorite, Sucrier, Pisang Mas, Dwarf Ducasse, Dwarf Red Dacca, Lady Finger. See Blue Sky Backyard Bananas for descriptions and orders - www.backyardbananas.com.au

Blueberry - (only rabbiteye, low chill types, plant 3 different types - grow easily from cuttings) 'Sharpblue', 'Biloxi', 'Gulfcoast', 'Brightwell', 'Premier', 'Climax

<u>Custard Apple</u> - 'Paxton's Prolific' - relatively new introduction, more reliable pollination/bearing

Fig (Grows easily from cuttings) 'Brown Turkey', 'Black Genoa'- both commercially grown varieties

Grapefruit (Buy grafted plants), 'Flame' (fewer seeds than Ruby or Red Blush), 'Ruby Red' or 'Red Blush', 'Thompson Seedless' - more subject to fruit fly; 'Marsh Seedless' - more subject to fruit fly

Lemon - 'Lots of Lemons' & Lemonicious - cutting grown & good for pots, but prone to fruit fly

'Meyer' – grafted & suitable for pots or gardens, but prone to fruit fly

'Eureka' - grafted, winter bearing, but some fruit year round

Bush – seed grown, highly variable, thick skin, juice content varies

'Villa Franca' - grafted, winter bearing with some summer and autumn fruit

'Lisbon' - grafted, winter bearing with fruit storing well

'Fino' - grafted, vigorous grower, thorny, seedless, winter bearing but some fruit year round

Lime - Native/Finger/Round limes - grafted selections include 'Rainforest Pearl' and 'Red Centre Blood Lime'. Late summer - early winter bearing, very hardy. Buy grafted for faster, more reliable fruiting.

'Tahitian' - mild flavour and best for our climate, rough lemon rootstock gives large tree and early crop while Poncirus trifoliata rootstock gives a smaller late harvest tree.

'West Indian Lime' (Mexican or Key Lime), prickly, with smaller seedy fruit. May be seed grown, cutting grown or grafted. Sublime is a cutting grown West Indian Lime.

Kaffir Lime – *Citrus hystrix* – seed or grafted.

Mandarin (buy grafted plants)

Early season include 'Clementine', 'Daisy', 'Imperial', 'Okitsu Wase', 'Satsuma' Mid season 'Dancy', 'Hickson' Late season - 'Afourer', 'Avana Tardivo', 'Ellendale', 'Honey Murcott'

Mango - Grafted or seed grown polyembryonic types ('Honey Gold', 'Bowen', 'R2E2')

Orange (buy grafted plants)

'Valencia' or 'Seedless Valencia' (slightly later fruiting); 'Joppa' (Dual purpose juicing and eating) 'Arnold Blood Orange'; 'Navel' (numerous different types)

Poor Man's Orange – seed grown, selected hybrid pummelo

Passionfruit - Grows easily from seed. 'Pandorea', 'Panana Red', 'Panama Gold', 'E-23', 'Lacey', 'Sunshine Special', 'Misty Gem', 'Inca Gold'. Avoid grafted Nellie Kelly and banana passionfruit

Pawpaw (Grows easily from seed). Save seed for good performing local variety

'Southern Red' - Bisexual, red fleshed. 'Richter x Sunnybank' - Yellow flesh, single sex sold 3 per pot

Mulberry (Grows easily from cuttings)

'Dwarf Black' (grafted), 'Red Shahtoot', 'White Shahtoot'. Select a cutting from a known fruiting plant.

Note: My preferred varieties identified in bold. Cutting grown citrus best suited to pots. Flying Dragon dwarfing rootstock available for most citrus varieties.
